Subject: Opposition to the Continued Employment of Reem Alsalam by the United Nations Human Rights Commission

We, the Official Fathers 4 Justice South Africa (F4J SA), are writing to express our strong opposition to the continued employment of Reem Alsalam by the United Nations Human Rights Commission. This marks our second communication to the Commission in the last 18 months, formally registering our deep concern and disapproval of Ms. Alsalam's conduct and her stance on Parental Alienation Syndrome (PAS).

We are deeply troubled by Ms. Alsalam's denial of the existence of PAS, which we believe actively undermines the mental, psychological, physical, and emotional well-being of children. Her stance is not only misguided but, in our view, exposes children to immediate and direct harm. By dismissing the reality of PAS, Ms. Alsalam is, in effect, perpetuating abuse and manipulation inflicted upon innocent children.

As a leading organization dedicated to advocating for the rights and welfare of children, Fathers 4 Justice South Africa (F4J SA) is profoundly disturbed by the continued association of the United Nations with Ms. Alsalam. Her actions and denial of PAS, in our opinion, qualify as a form of child abuse. We urge that she be held accountable for the impact of her stance, which we believe warrants serious consequences.

The United Nations' continued association with Ms. Alsalam casts a long, dark shadow over its reputation and raises significant questions about its commitment to child welfare. It is imperative that the organization take immediate action to demonstrate its genuine care for the welfare of children and the integrity of its mission.

We demand that the United Nations not renew Ms. Alsalam's appointment and permanently ban her from working with the United Nations or any of its associates. Additionally, she should be prohibited from referencing her tenure at the United Nations in any future employment.

The damage inflicted by Ms. Alsalam's stance on PAS is profound and far-reaching, causing untold suffering and distress. Her actions undermine the principles of justice and child welfare that the United Nations purports to uphold.

Fathers 4 Justice South Africa urges the United Nations Human Rights Commission to formally recognize Parental Alienation Syndrome (PAS) as a form of child abuse and intimate partner violence. We believe it is crucial to address PAS as violent, emotional, coercive, and manipulative abuse, often perpetrated against fathers by mothers. The United Nations has a clear opportunity to rectify this situation and restore faith in its commitment to child welfare. We strongly urge you to take immediate and decisive action by removing Ms. Alsalam from her position and not renewing her employment contract.
